I have enjoyed reading this series and the light mystery is entertaining, although the implication that Jane is the only one who can ever solve it is implausible. The writing has improved over the length of the series. I really love the back story about Jane's family and can't wait to find out about her father, her mother, the false sister, the witch hunters and her family history. The downside... I really wish the characters were more developed; even Jane's character seems one-dimensional; she seems to involve the other characters only if she needs them and with little warmth. There's no real chemistry between Jane and Max and, again, Max seems to be no more than a supporting role to her. I'd like to see him as a true partner. Some of the language phrases are pretty dated too making it difficult to tell how old the main character is and what era this takes place in. On the whole, I would recommend the series. It's light, entertaining and a quick read. Can't wait to see what happens to the family next.

This was a good murder mystery. The suspects were many, which allows the reader to use the clues to try to solve the murder before Jane announces it. I agree with another reviewer in that Jane should not be the only one to solve these murders. Max and even Anthony could have bigger roles

in the solving, after all they are detectives so they shouldn't be stupid. I also think the characters need to become more well fleshed out characters and not so stiff and two dimensional. As far as I'm concerned the murders are only a catalyst to getting to the real story: the mystery with Jane's family! Jane's father is lying about Raven being their sister. I think her mother might be lying also. I also don't trust her mother and Thomas and why they want the "blue stone" which her father must have. Is Raven a witch hunter? Whose side is her father really on? What allowed her mother to come back from the dead and why? I'm hoping book 7 will soon be published and will have some answers to these questions and more twists and turns about Jane's family. That's the mystery which keeps me reading!!!
