

One of the most thorough and comprehensive books I've seen about how many of the US environmental policies evolved. Layzer builds the cases with historical context, case law, and social aspects. For example, using the Dudley Street case in Boston, she builds the case for environmental justice issues. The events at Love Canal lead to the Superfund Act (CERCLA). A must-read for students of environmental policy!

The key ones that developed the environmental laws of today (Love Canal) and ones (Chesapeake Bay) that are now pushing policy and environmental groups forward.
