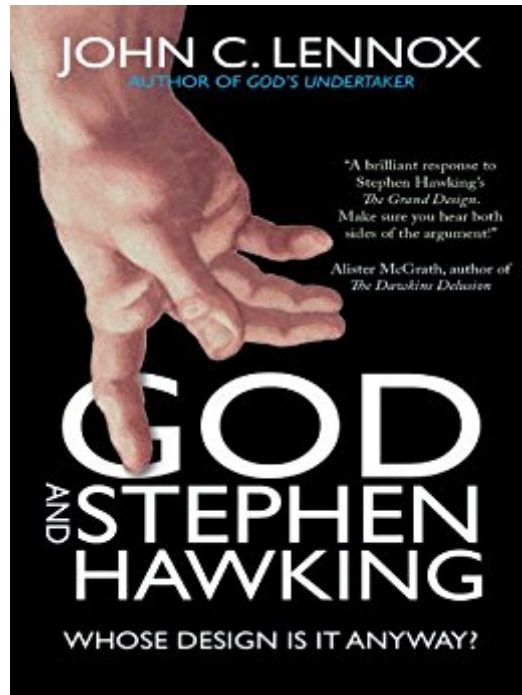


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God And Stephen Hawking: Whose Design Is It Anyway?
