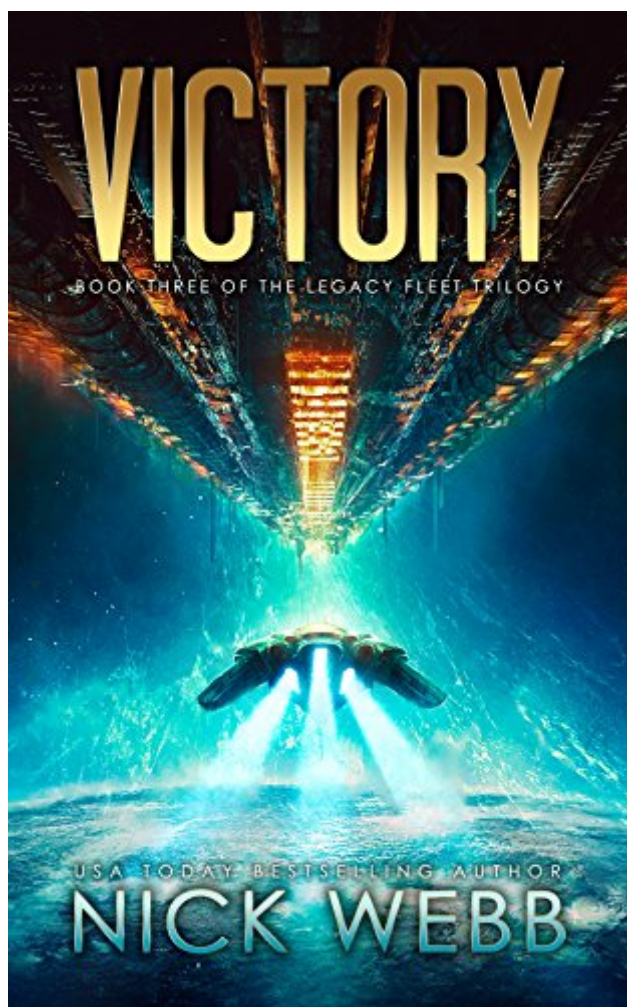


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Victory: Book 3 Of The Legacy Fleet Trilogy

In Victory, Book 3 of the Legacy Fleet Trilogy, Nick Webb does a fantastic job of tying up the loose ends and providing a satisfying ending to a great story. Unlike many books I read, I could never figure out exactly where the story was going in the Legacy Fleet Trilogy and Victory was no exception. Webb continually added twists and turns to the plot that kept me guessing and anticipating where he was taking me. In the end, the story came to the end I expected and wanted, but the route he took was circuitous, unpredictable, and extremely satisfying. Webb succeeded in weaving a complex host of characters into his tale. The intrepid Captain Granger provided the strong lead required to drive the story forward with bone crushing force and intensity. He was a hero's hero, the kind of man who does the right thing regardless of what others think or the personal cost to himself. His simplicity of motives bore out a complex man. Other character's such as President Avery were much less transparent. I couldn't decide whether I liked her or hated her until the end. The main characters are well fleshed out and supporting characters are given enough attention to keep them interesting. The action was so brutal I could feel it. Webb repeatedly drew out battles for pages and pages and pages, but he kept the action so intense and so vivid, that you will become inescapably caught in his grip of suspense. He kept me desperate for the next word and then the next paragraph and the the next page and the next chapter. Webb uses science to put the final touches of realism and authenticity on his masterfully crafted world. Unlike many who try, Webb succeeds in using the laws of physics and theoretical sciences to convince the reader that the events he portrays could actually occur.

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
